

## American Society of Plumbing Engineers - Atlanta Chapter Scholarship

### Eligibility Requirements:

1. Scholarship limited to ASPE members (including Student Members) and immediate family (spouse, child & grandchild).
2. The eligible individual applicant shall meet a., b., and c. below:
  - a. Enrolled, as of the application year, as a full time student in a college, university or vocational school.
  - b. Have maintained a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale; or its equivalent.
  - c. Is enrolled in a school or program of engineering or construction.

***Exception:** In the event that no applicants meet all three requirements noted above, the Board may waive requirement c., at its discretion. Applicants meeting all three above requirements will, in every case, be given first preference over applicants who are not enrolled in an engineering or construction program*

OR

3. The eligible individual applicant must meet a., b., c, and d. below:
  - a. A senior high school student who will graduate as of June of the application year.
  - b. Have maintained a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale; or its equivalent.
  - c. Plans to matriculate into a college, university or vocational school on a full time basis as of the fall or summer semester of the application year.
  - d. Plans to enroll in a school or program of engineering or construction.

***Exception:** In the event that no applicants meet all four requirements noted above, the Board may waive requirement d., at its discretion. Applicants meeting all four above requirements will, in every case, be given first preference over applicants not enrolling in an engineering or construction program.*

### **Application Process:**

1. Scholarship Application
2. School Transcript (5 percentage points)
3. (4) References (15 percentage points)
  - a. (2) Family, Friends, Coworkers
  - b. (2) Teachers, Professors, School Counselors & School Principal
4. Personal Activities and Community Involvement (15 percentage points)
  - a. Extracurricular Activities
  - b. Community Involvement
  - c. Awards and Certificates
  - d. Work Study Programs
5. Statement of Personal Achievement (30 percentage points)
  - a. Requires applicant to give insight about themselves to the Atlanta Chapter Board. The applicant should consider the impact that he/she has had on people around them, including friends, family & strangers. In addition, applicant can include statement about how the world is better place because of their presence. Maximum 200 words
6. Essay of Interest (35 percentage points)
  - a. Each applicant is required to respond to a question (i.e. *As a future Engineer you are asked to build the 10<sup>th</sup> Wonder of the World, What will you be building?*”). The question is designed to empower the applicant to be thoughtful, insightful and creative. Maximum 200 words
